

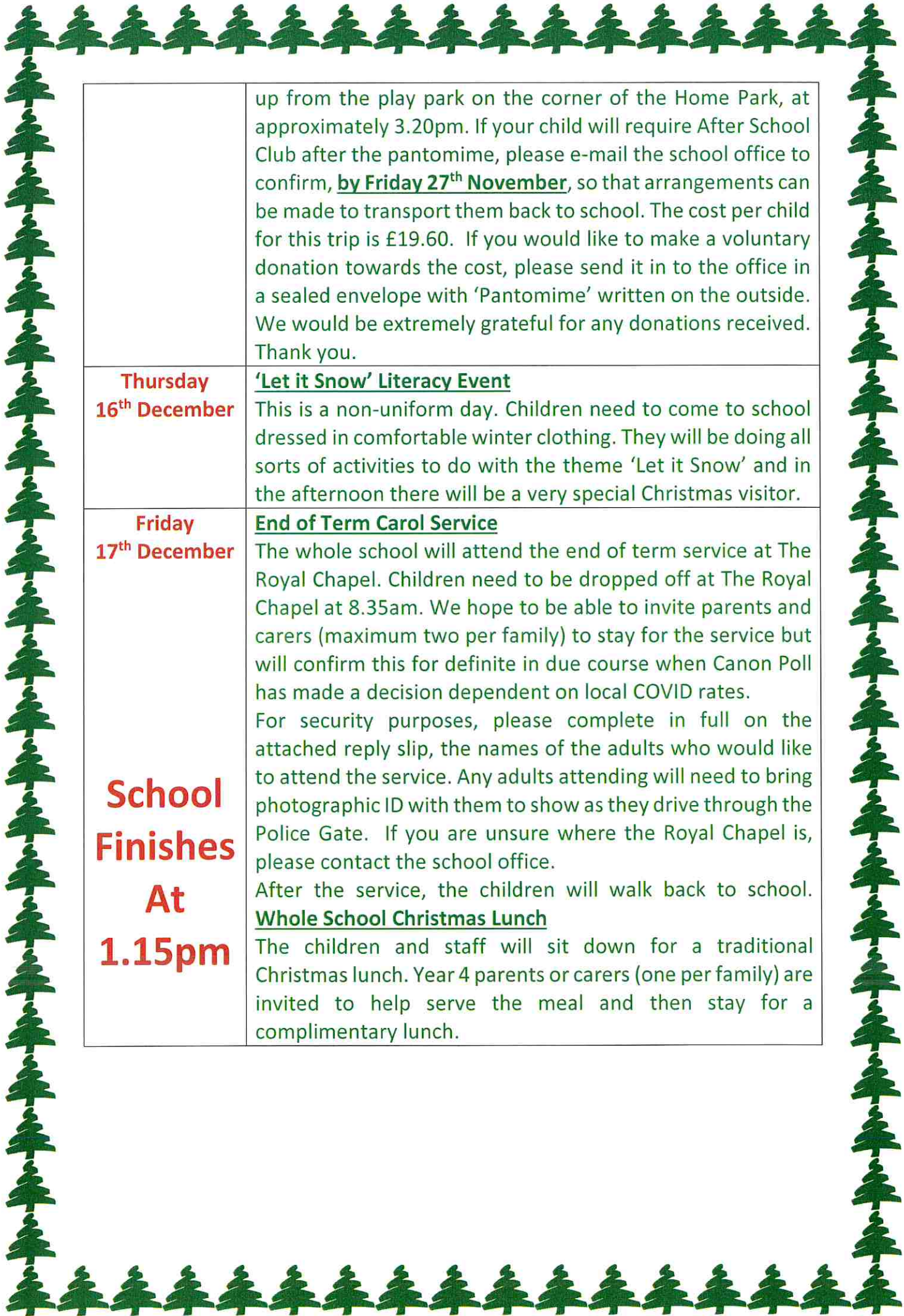


## The Royal School
